

Policy Framework 1 - Responding to requests from Member Organisations

When approached by a member organisation about a relevant event, campaign or project Supreme Sikh Council UK could adopt 1 of 4 approaches:

- i) Minimalist approach – acknowledge the event, campaign or project being organised, but point out it is not appropriate for the Supreme Sikh Council UK to be directly associated with the event and wish them luck for the event.
- ii) Inform Supreme Sikh Council UK member organisations – provide information to member organisations about the event, campaign or project and leave them to decide if and how they wish to support.
- iii) Supportive role – continue to let member organisation lead the event, campaign or project, but agree to support by providing input via relevant sub-committee or nominate executive committee members to work with the lead organisation.
- iv) Take the lead – Request the member organisation to allow the Supreme Sikh Council UK to take the lead for the event, campaign or project
